Dear Property Owner,

Thank you for inquiring about having electric power restored to your property.

As per JCP&L and BPU (Board of Public Utility) regulations, a permit is not required to restore service that has been disconnected by JCP&L for non-payment or non-usage.

It is the property owner's responsibility to submit to JCP&L, a letter from a licensed electrical contractor, on company letterhead, stating that he /she has visually examined the service. The letter should state that the service has not been tampered with or vandalized, and it is acceptable for power to be restored.

This letter should be faxed to JCP&L's Metering Dept. at 1-888-914-9140.

Should the electrician find that work is needed to restore the service to safe condition, a construction permit will then be required, and a cut-in card would be issued by the Electrical Inspector after work completion.

IF JCPL insists that the Township Inspector must inspect, then your electrician should take out the permit and include his letter certifying the safe condition of the service. Once the permit is approved, an inspection can then be scheduled when the electrician can meet the inspector at the property. After a successful inspection, a cut-in card would then be issued by the inspector.
